

SCRUTINIZER'S REPORT

I, Dinesh Joshi, Partner, KANJ & Associates, Company Secretaries, Pune, have been appointed by the Board of Directors of Deepak Nitrite Limited (the Company) vide Board Resolution dated 11th December 2017 as Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot voting process for the following resolution as Special Resolution:

- **Issue of Equity Shares of face value of Rs. 2/- each for an aggregate amount not exceeding Rs.150 crores through Qualified Institutions Placement ("QIP") in accordance with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2009 ("SEBI ICDR").**

I submit my Report as under:

1. The Company has completed on Monday, 18th December, 2017 the dispatch of Postal Ballots along with postage pre-paid business reply envelopes to its Members whose names appeared on the Register of Members as on Friday, 8th December, 2017.
2. The Postal Ballot forms received from members were kept under safe custody.
3. The Postal Ballot forms received up to 6.00 PM IST on Tuesday, 16th January 2018, the last date and time fixed by the Company for receipt of Postal Ballot forms were considered for scrutiny.
4. Envelopes containing postal ballot forms received after Tuesday, 16th January 2018 were not considered for my scrutiny.
5. In case of postal ballot forms which were found incomplete or where shareholders opted for both the options or where the signature of shareholders found mismatched with the records available, such postal ballot forms were considered as invalid and rejected.




6. Envelopes containing Postal Ballot forms returned undelivered were not opened and they are separately kept.
7. I received no Postal Ballot paper in defaced / mutilated condition.
8. As per Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 e-voting facility was also made available to all the Members to cast their votes electronically as an optional facility to physical Postal Ballot Form. The facility for e-voting was made available on www.evotingindia.com where the Members were provided with the Login ID and Password which would enable them to vote.
9. Members availing E-Voting Facility, were requested to cast their Votes electronically between Monday, 18th December 2017 (9.00 AM IST) and Tuesday, 16th January 2018 (6.00 PM IST).
10. In case members casted their votes by both the means then in that case E - voting has been considered for scrutiny and voting via Postal Ballot Form considered as invalid.
11. A total of 218 Postal Ballots and 104 e-votes have been received from the Members which have been scrutinized by me to ascertain the assent or dissent of the Members and the summary of same is as under:

A Special resolution was proposed for postal ballot with regard to:

Issue of Equity Shares of face value of Rs. 2/- each for an aggregate amount not exceeding Rs.150 crores through Qualified Institutions Placement ("QIP") in accordance with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2009 ("SEBI ICDR").
